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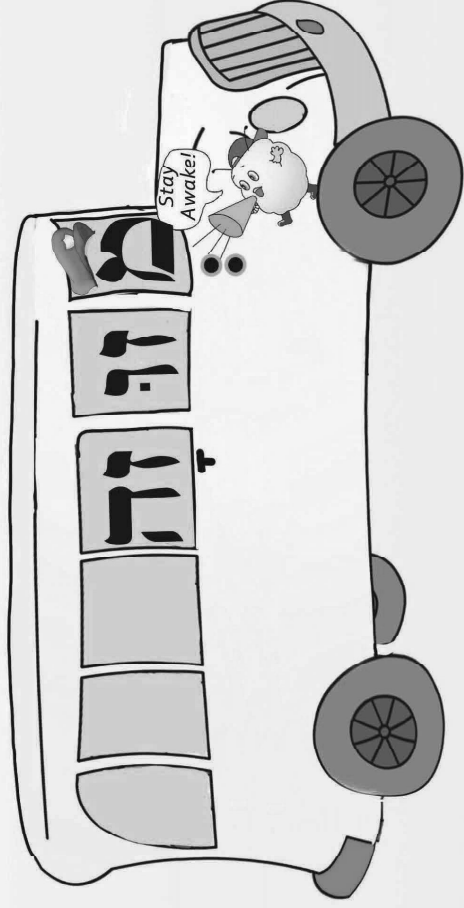
שוא בראש מיטה #1: Sh'va Rule

When a sh'va is at the beginning (front) of a word, it's like the *busdriver* - it must stay "awake" (make a sound).

Ex. רבוקה קנדה שמע

Note: In contrast, a sh'va in the very back of a bus is asleep **NO MATTER WHAT!**

"Busdriver" Sh'va rule.



Find the "busdriver" sh'vas -
read them loud and clear!
